



## INDUSTRIAL GENERAL STORM WATER PERMIT

**The new Industrial General Permit (IGP) for Storm Water applies to many types of facilities that were previously exempt, and includes many new requirements.**

Facilities covered under the new IGP include but are not limited to the following:

- Oil and gas production; refineries; petroleum and petrochemical processing, products and storage;
- Manufacturing and Industrial facilities; shipyards; airports; port facilities
- Sand and gravel operations; active and inactive mining operations; cement, asphalt and raw materials processing, manufacturing
- Steam-electric power generation that includes combustion of fuels
- Hazardous and non-hazardous waste treatment storage or disposal; landfills; land application
- Recycling and salvage yards; vehicle maintenance and fuelling
- Sewage and wastewater treatment plants

If your facility is new to the IGP or needs to re-certify, InterAct can determine if your facility can be exempted from the permit or qualifies for a No-Exposure Certification. If permit coverage is required, InterAct can update your existing Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) or develop a new SWPPP with Best Management Practices (BMPs) appropriate to your site and a simplified monitoring plan that takes advantage of the reductions offered in the IGP.
